

Flitterman Collection

Since 1981, Flitterman Collection has been designing, curating and producing fully custom woven goods for the hospitality and residential markets. Karen Flitterman began importing from her father, Harry Flitterman who was a world-renowned, award-winning designer and entrepreneur since the 1950's. She became the US distributor of his creations which had been handwoven in Portugal for many years.

Upon Harry's passing in 1987, Karen took over the manufacturing at the Portuguese factory which stayed open for many years following. Upon that factory's closing in 1998, a new factory was created right here in Southern California. From there, Karen designs and oversees the weaving of custom handwoven rugs as well as macrame, woven wall hangings and other woven products. Partnering with some of the most respected designers and showrooms in the country, her handmade products are renown throughout the US. In addition to the weaving facility in Southern California, Flitterman Collection has cultivated partnerships with two long-established and highly-respected weaving factories in India, allowing for the production of Karen's custom woven goods to be supplied to the global hospitality market.

Flitterman Collection has been proud to collaborate in the design details for many projects, both commercial and residential, throughout the years and we welcome new partnerships and collaborators to continue doing so well into the future.

Using Karen's "Arabesque" pattern as just one example, your options for material, color, scale, and even shape create nearly infinite combinations and design possibilities.



Materials



If it can we woven, Karen can do it!

Karen is renown for her leather rugs and outdoor, aka "Afuera" vinyl rugs but wool, jute, sisal, acrylic, and PET are all frequent specifications for hospitality and residential projects.

For residential projects, additional non-commercial materials such as cotton, upcycled denim, upcycled "rag", etc. are also wonderful options!

Whether your project is hospitality, commercial, or residential, the range of materials available (or combinations thereof) are seemingly limitless.

If your project requires rugs, wall art, macrame, upholstery, wall panels, or just about anything else you can imagine, you can be confident that Flitterman Collection has the sources, skill and capabilities to accomplish your design goals.

Information for Specification

Material Sourcing

Over decades, Flitterman Collection has cultivated a network of sources for their materials. In most cases, Karen either has long-established distribution agreements or receives preferred/manufacturer's pricing.

These relationships allow her to source nearly any materials at optimal pricing. As a specifier, allowing Karen to use her own suppliers will provide you with the most cost-effective pricing and budget flexibility. It will also ensure that the material has already been tested to ensure its suitbility for your application.

Flitterman Collection gladly accepts COM/COL!

Leather and vinyl are frequently specified as such. It is important to understand, however, that not all leather and vinyl are suitable for weaving. Characteristics such as thickness, rigididy, pliability, flexibility, etc. must all be considered in order to determine whether a material is suitable for your application.

When specifying your own material to be woven, it will be necessary to provide Flitterman Collection with a 6"x6" minimum sample in order to test it's viability.

When is comes to leather as COL, it is advisable to consider **Moore & Giles** for your specifications for several reasons. Karen has worked in partnership with Moore & Giles for many years. In fact, two of the woven leathers that Moore & Giles offers are actually exclusive patterns, developed & manufactured, to-order, by Karen.

This also means that many Moore & Giles articles - from flat leathers to hair-on-hides - have already been tested for weaving which can save you to time and effort.

For those articles that haven't been tested, samples can be quickly acquired, in some cases the same day, due to Karen's close relationship with Moore & Giles' local sales representatives.

More significantly, their shared history and relationship allow you, in many instances, to source Moore & Giles at manufacturer's pricing if Karen purchases it.

Pricing & Spec Writing

Whether you're writing your rug spec or just requesting pricing, the following information is the minimum general information Karen will need in order to provide accurate pricing. Pricing for things like macramé or other specialty items have many variables so generally speaking, the more info you can provide, the better. For rugs, pillows, or other common woven goods, the following basic info should be provided:

- Size/sizes
- Shape (if other than rectangle)
- Quantity
- End use/application
- Material
- Is the material COM or Karen's suppliers?
- Pattern. If not known or custom, you can either provide: -an inspiration image.


-a drawing.

-arrange a consultation with Karen.

-Share your design narrative and allow Karen to create designs for you.

- Color/colors
- Is the rug for an inlay?
- What is your preferred edging/binding?
- Does the rug require backing?

This information will also allow Karen to determine where best to manufacture your spec - at her Newbury Park factory or her India factory.



Additional Information

- If the shape is other than rectangular or a circle, a template will need to be provided prior to production (or prototype/model room if applicable).
- If providing an inspiration image, keep in mind that Karen does not "knock off" other suppliers. Any inspiration image from another manufacturer will need to be altered in the range of about 20% in order to ensure that copyrights are not infringed upon and also to maintain the integrity of Karen's art.
- Karen's largest loom (the largest of it's kind in the US) can produce pieces up to 180" wide (max) x infinite length. Rugs wider than 180" can also be produced but must be paneled.
- All rugs should expect a dimensional tolerance of +/- 3%. For example, a 15'0" rug could have a final dimension of 14'6". If this is not an acceptable variance, the rug must be paneled.
- This can vary, but when calculating your budget for COM/COL, a rule of thumb is 5-6 SF of leather or vinyl yields 1 SF of woven goods.
- When specifying wool, there is a one-time, \$250 per color dye charge. Karen's supplier's wool is not stocked in color and is dyed to order.



Lead Times

Typical Lead Times

As a custom-only manufacturer, not only is every project unique, but also an opportunity to create new and exciting works of art and explore different applications. As such, lead times can vary by product and project.

Generally speaking, lead times for hospitality rugs or woven upholstery can typically be estimated as follows:

- Quotes 1-3 business days
- US Samples for Approval 7-10 business days
- US Production 8-12 weeks (typically per rug)
- India Samples for Approval 5-6 weeks
- India Full Production 12-14 weeks (full order)
- Macrame, wall art, and other specialty products can only be determined on a case-by-case basis.





Understanding Lead Times

Whether your spec is made in Newbury Park, CA or India, you will be receiving a product that is entirely hand-made/hand-loomed. There is no automation used in the manufacturing of your specs. When compared to similarly manufactured product, her lead times are extremely competitive. That said, it is not Flitterman Collection's intent or desire to compete on time with rug suppliers with automated capbilities, inline products, or stocked inventory.

Whether your need a single macrame piece for a residential client or 200 guestroom rugs, when you specify Flitterman Collection you are making a statement that you, the designer, appreciate the art of hand weaving and want your client and their end users to receive a product that has a story. Part of that story is the appreciation of the process involved in crafting these beautiful one-of-a-kind products. A process that takes just a little bit longer and a lot more heart than doing so with automation.

Most importantly, you know that it's worth it!















Manufacturing Newbury Park vs India

Finding Solutions

The scope and scale of your project will ultimately determine which factory is best suited to produce your pieces.

Certain creations can only be made at Karen's Newbury Park factory while for other products, the India factory may only have those capabilities.

Quantities also play a factor. Both Newbury Park and India provide the same level of quality with bespoke, hand-made, hand-loomed custom works of art designed by Karen Flitterman. But while the Newbury Park factory has 6 manual looms, the India factory has hundreds and can handle guestroom volume.

While India may handle the bulk of the guestrooms, they can also produce for smaller quantities, public spaces and individual pieces. Conversely, Newbury Park can produce things like macrame and wall art, pillows, accessories and even certain rugs for guestrooms. It really just depends on the specifics of a given project.

Regardless of the product, design, materials, or quantities, rest assured The Flitterman Collection has the capability to deliver on virtually any project








